It was a great experience meeting many of our connections in person, and discovering more about the latest innovations in technology through interactive workshops, live hands-on demos, and engaging sessions conducted by the salesforce experts. Some of the key takeaways from the developer event of the year were:


1. Salesforce is launching Einstein GPT to deliver auto-generated AI content within Salesforce

2. A new Mascot for flow builders has been introduced, called Flo the Flying Squirrel

3. Salesforce also announced that there are now over 900 out-of-the-box Flow templates for developers to use. This will make automation way faster and help simplify business processes

4. During the True to Core session at TrailblazerDX, Salesforce announced free integration user licenses. Starting from March 14, 2023, enterprise, performance, and unlimited edition orgs will receive five free Salesforce integration user licenses

5. The Salesforce Trailhead platform is being extended with Trailhead Coach to help individuals pursuing a career in the Salesforce ecosystem



Tech Session - March '23

Infoglen has been conducting a series of sessions called 'Tech Sessions'. These sessions aim to bring the Infoglen team members up to date on all the latest features released or updated, and old ones that Salesforce has replaced or removed. Team members deep dive into selected features, answer each other's questions about the latest developments and give demos to see the features in action.

On March 17, a Tech Session was organized by our in-house Salesforce Architect and Salesforce Developer, who gave an overview and demos on Salesforce's latest and deprecated features from the Spring Release 2023. Some of the features covered during the session were:

1. HTTP Callout from Flow - one of the most important features of flow to be introduced in the Spring Release. Using the new HTTP Callout (Beta) button, you can now make calls to external web services, without using any code.

2. Reactive Screen Components (Beta) - You can now customize screen components to react to user actions on the same page. In the past, this was only possible by placing components on different screens.

3. Elements - If you are trying to work with flow for the first time, you can hover over icons to see a description about the elements that have been added and find out the operation of that element.

4. Migrate to Flow - You can now convert processes built on process builder to Flow.

5. Lookup Support & Multi-Select Picklist Support - Dynamic Forms for Flow now support multi-select picklist fields and lookup

7. Reverse Formula - you can now use the Reverse function while building formulas, to enter the character of the source string with the reverse order

8. Dynamic forms are now available for Leads and Cases as well

9. Set Field level security for permission sets during field creation (beta)

10. Bulk Management picklist values - You can now delete, activate, deactivate, or replace multiple custom picklist field values at once.
